Tiverton's central location makes it an ideal base for exploring Devon and the place to escape to for a rural holiday. Surrounded by countryside walks and traditional thatched villages like Bickleigh and Thorverton dotted along the picturesque Exe Valley.



Country Park where one of the country's last


