Society of Friends (Quaker) records held for Devon East Division and Exeter. Tiverton Register Office Marriage Notice Books 1837-1939 are held on microfilm. These record notices of marriages in Non-conformist Chapels/Churches in the Tiverton Registration District & Tiverton Register Office and in such places elsewhere where one party may have resided outside the Tiverton Registration District.
